# "KingKak"



## **MATERIAL:**

1x Glam from Durable (130 m / 50 g, 75% cotton, 25% acrylic,) (total weight 17 Gramm)

**Crochet hook:** 4 mm (6 US) (BPdc - back post double crochet)

## Key:

ch - chain
hdc - half double crochet
dc - double crochet
sl st - slip stitch
BPdc - back post double crochet



Work 3 ch. 11 dc in the first ch. Close with sl st to the round.

#### 1. round:

2 ch. Double each dc. Close with sl st to the round.

## 2. round:

2 ch. Repeat through the round: (1 dc, double 1 dc). Close with sl st to the round.

#### 3. round:

2 ch. Repeat through the round: (2 dc, double 1 dc). Close with sl st to the round.

## 4. round:


2 ch. Repeat through the round: (3 dc, double 1 dc). Close with sl st to the round.

#### 5. round:

2 ch. Crochet BPdc till the end of the round. Close with sl st to the round.

#### 6. round:

2 ch. Crochet dc till the end of the round. Close with sl st to the round.



#### 7. round:

2 ch. Crochet dc at the edge till the end of the round. Close with sl st to the round.

## 8. round:

1 ch. For the crown repeat: (1 sl st, 1 hdc, 1 dc, 3 ch, work sl st in the first ch, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 1 sl st) till the end of the row. If you have few stitches left, just smuggle some sl st till the end of the row. Close with sl st to the round.

Cut the thread. Sew in all threads.
